Guideline

- *Total Holidays in 2022 are Nine (9), 5 national and 4 restricted holidays chosen by the individual and availed after approval from PL, PL needs to get approval from Management.
- *Please note Holiday Dates can vary depending on Calendar Calculation.
- *Please note none of holidays or in Lieu offs can be broken into half days .All holidays or In Lieu offs needs to be taken as full offs.
- * All offs to be considered only when pre-approved by PL. Approval from PL is mandatory in all the cases.
- *No more than 5 consecutive offs/Holidays together at any time including weekends (Saturday/Sunday), as these will be considered auto rejected.
 Unapproved and/or more than 5 consecutive offs will be considered as LWP.
- *All unapproved leaves to be considered unpaid time offs and may result in disciplinary action and penalties.

National Holidays - 2022

^{*}People working on Holi and Diwali will be marked double working day for one day of work.

^{*}Meal will be provided to all the employees working on National holidays.

Restricted Holidays - 2022

- *PL will review coverage requirements and resource availability to approve offs on these days.
- *Restricted Holidays are Valid till December 2022. Every Individual is requested to take leaves till Dec 2022.
- *Two adjoining Restricted holiday can't be taken or clubbed with other holiday. This requires PM and VP level approval, if needed at all.
